Monday, December 26th

Snowman Soup and Poem

While listening to a poem, "Snowman Soup", the children will make a yummy cup of snowman soup with mini-marshmallows, candy canes, and warm hot chocolate.

Snowball Fight

Children will have a "snowball" fight using white tissue. Each team will try to throw their snowballs across the line. The least amount of snowballs when the timer goes off wins!

Winter Songs and Storytelling

Children will listen to winter storybooks and participate by singing and dancing to festive songs.

Tuesday, December 27th

Warm Snowman on a Cold Day Snack Activity

Cooking activity where each child will make a "snowman" by using refrigerated biscuits, pretzel sticks and raisins. Once baked, your child will enjoy this delicious treat with butter or honey.

Snowball Hunt and Races

Children will hide cotton balls around the room. With empty egg cartons, the children will try to fill cups labeled 1-12 with the hidden "snowballs". Then they will put on their mittens and balance a "snow ball" on a spoon as they race across the room. The first team to fill their bucket with snowballs wins!

The Snowy Day Read Aloud & Finger Painting Activity

After reading The Snowy Day by Ezra Jack Keats, the children will create their own snowy scene by painting with a stick or their fingers to make a trail just like Peter did in the snow.

Cookie Decorating

With Christmas and winter cookie cutters, children will bake cookies, decorate, and eat their creations.

Let It Snow Parachute Games

Children will enjoy tossing cotton balls in our giant parachute letting it "snow" inside Kids Cottage!

Mitten Story and Craft

After listening to the storybook The Mitten by Jan Brett, the children will decorate felt mittens with stickers, glitter paint and ribbon.

Thursday, December 30th

Jingle the Giant Jellyfish Read Aloud

Children will make their own Jingle the Giant Jellyfish just like the one in the story.

Craft Spoon Snowman Magnet

Children will paint wooden craft spoons white, cut and glue hats, scarves, eyes, noses, mouth and buttons on and attach a magnet to the back.

Doughnut Snowman

Children will use mini-doughnuts, doughnut holes, and pretzel sticks to make their snowman. They will use decorators gel to add a face, buttons, a carrot nose and a Hershey kiss as his hat.

Friday, December 31st

Going on a Santa Trip

Children will be asked to sit in a large circle. The first player will say, "On Christmas Eve I'm traveling with Santa and I'm going to take...(something that begins with the letter A)." The next player will repeat the first object and will add an object that begins with the letter B. This will continue until all of the letters of the alphabet have been included.

Holiday Cookie Cutter Creations

Children will have the opportunity to create their own holiday snack from start to finish!

Pencil Snowman

Children will use a combination of pencils, felt, small jingle bells, buttons, pipe cleaners and a few other supplies to design their own snowman.
